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CEO 2022/2023 REPORT & PERFORMANCE OVERVIEW

ICPA CEO Jackie Maimin

Welcome to the 2023 ICPA 7th Conference and Exhibition!
It is an honour and privilege to engage once more with all ICPA members in person.

This year our theme is “R5 Rise, Reconnect, Recover, Rebuild and Re-energise”. This year’s conference is aimed at assisting independents to navigate the future. We aim to achieve this through our knowledge-packed 2-day symposium, an introduction to all current and future pharmacy-initiated projects, and assisting our members to continue to enhance their professional knowledge, stay inspired, and continue serving their communities.

The exhibition area has a plethora of exhibitors, many of the usual loyal supporters, and a growing number of new ones. All exhibitors bring something unique in value to our Independent Pharmacists, to help guide the way for our pharmacists into the future.

Our trusted statutory councils, SAPC and SAHPRA will have stands to assist members with any statutory queries, and our sister organization, the PSSA will also be in attendance.

We have a 2-day symposium which is packed with local and international speakers which we guarantee will offer all ICPA members a great learning opportunity and will fulfill your CPD requirements for the year!

ICPA 12th Annual General Meeting 2023

This will be ICPA’s Twelfth Annual General Meeting, and we are thrilled to announce that we have achieved our twelfth consecutive clean audit opinion. However, a clean audit in the absence of service delivery and achievement of strategic objectives would be meaningless. This report overview will give members an idea of the volume and value of our actual operational output.

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Legal Portfolio Updates - 2022/2023

Our legal portfolio has been kept very busy over the past year and in this short report I will endeavour to unpack these as well as progress on each legal matter to date

Constitutional Court Judgment 28 March 2023

Following a protracted legal battle in the Western Cape High Court and the Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) between ICPA and the Clicks Group, ICPA on 22 September 2022 argued the case on pharmacy ownership and patient rights before the apex court.

On 28 March 2023, the Constitutional Court through Justice Rogers, writing the judgment for the majority, agreed with ICPA. He states that;

"The preference for a more generous interpretation is fortified by the Constitution. I have already mentioned the injunction in Section 39(2) of the Bill of Rights. Section 27(1) of the Bill of Rights guarantees to everyone, amongst other things, the right to have access to healthcare services. In terms of Section 27(2), the state must take reasonable legislative and other measures, within its available resources, to achieve the progressive realisation of this right. The dispensing of medicines by community pharmacies is an important part of health care services. An interpretation which promotes more effectively the best interests of the clients of the community pharmacists should be preferred over one which gives greater scope for perverse commercial incentives. There is nothing in the spirit, purport or objects of the Bill of Rights which pulls in the other direction."

We await the sanctions that the DG of Health will impose on Clicks. In the interim, we have requested that both SAPC and the NDoH place a moratorium on any licence applications by Clicks until such time the Clicks group is no longer in contravention of the Pharmacy Act. Both SAPC and NDoH have agreed to the moratorium.

Complaints have been lodged with CMS regarding similar vertically integrated organisations including Pharmacy Direct and its sister company, Activo.

Council for Medical Schemes – DSP Issue

ICPA has been battling with the Council for Medical Schemes for years now to have them declare the practices of medical schemes appointing closed DSPs and the imposing of penalty co-payments as undesirable. On 23 April 2021, CMS published a declaration in the Government Gazette declaring these practices by medical schemes as undesirable in terms of Section 61 of the Medical Schemes Act.

Unfortunately, Health Funders Association NPC, Discovery Health Medical Scheme, Discovery Health (Pty) Ltd, Malcor Medical Aid Scheme, Momentum Health Administrator, Momentum Medical Scheme, Multichoice Medical Aid Scheme, Profmed Medical Scheme, Remedi Medical Aid Scheme, SAB Medical Aid Scheme, Tsogo Sun Medical Aid Scheme, University of Kwazulu-Natal Medical Scheme have appealed the decision to publish the declaration.

ICPA applied to be joined as a party to the appeal hearings, which application was approved, but to date, the CMS Appeal Board has not given us a date for the hearing.

ICPA is trying all available avenues to expedite the process.

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Pharmacy Licence Objections

ICPA continues to assist members who object to applications for pharmacy licences that do not fulfill the criteria of need as published by the Minister. The latest challenge is a pharmacy owner has found a loophole in the licence application process. An application for a community licence was successfully challenged by ICPA and the application for the community pharmacy licence was not approved.

The applicant then applied for an institutional pharmacy licence that does not have the same population and proximity criteria as a community pharmacy licence application. An institutional pharmacy is required by law to service in-patients in a health facility. The challenge is defining a health facility which varies across provinces.

ICPA is working with the affected member and the NDoH to close this loophole and to ensure we do not have community pharmacies operating under an institutional pharmacy licence.

Funders & Pharmacy Services Portfolio

Much work has been done under the Funders and Pharmacy Services portfolio. ICPA is at an advanced stage of negotiation with the National Department of Health to put a Service Level Agreement in place allowing pharmacists to obtain COVID-19 vaccines at no charge from the provinces. The SLA will allow for additional services to be added which include the provision of family planning, EPI, HPV, and flu vaccinations, HIV self-screening test kits, deworming, and vitamin A supplementation to uninsured patients using state stock.

Contracted pharmacies would supply state stock at no charge but would be allowed to charge the patient a fee for the rendering of the service.

Medical Schemes Updates

Meetings are regularly held with medical schemes, administrators, forensic units, and CMS itself. ICPA has assisted members with unfair scheme audits and is negotiating with forensic units to ensure pharmacies undergo a fair and transparent process that is not too onerous.

Pharmacy clinic services remain a key focus area for Independent Community Pharmacy, and most medical schemes have a rich variety of clinic benefits for scheme members where pharmacies can offer a paid-for service that contributes to the health and well-being of their patients. **A real win-win situation.** ICPA urges all members to invest in primary health clinics as we move away from our dependency on medicine sales to true pharmaceutical care with a focus on positive therapeutic outcomes.

Independent Pharmacy Projects Partnerships

ICPA continues to look for funding for new services such as PIMART, Kamba Ya Shanga asthma services, HIV testing, and COVID-19 vaccinations. SAPC successfully defended a case brought about by IPAF which was seeking to have the PIMART Board Notice withdrawn. They have now applied for leave to appeal which has been granted and the case will be heard in the Supreme Court of Appeal. SAPC strongly supports PIMART and has indicated that they will take the matter all the way to the Constitutional Court if needs be.

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Education Portfolio

Strategic Objective 1, includes campaigns aimed at highlighting the services independents provide to the public. This year we have taken part in the ICPA Flu Campaign, May Measure Month, and a very successful Pharmacy Month. All campaigns include extensive media coverage and member support. Still to come is the diabetes campaign and World Aids Day. ICPA secured 50,000 free HIV self-screening test kits for members to sell below R50 as part of a demand creation project with PSI.

The campaign has been extremely successful, showing that pharmacies are the preferred provider of these kits. Many pharmacies sold their allocation of 120 kits in a month or two and we have sent more kits to satisfy demand. Stakeholders including the media and the Department of Health seek out comments, advice, and support from ICPA.

The COVID-19 pandemic really highlighted the value of community pharmacy in the eyes of the public and the government. We provided care and assistance during a very difficult time, and we were actively involved in a successful COVID-19 vaccination roll-out. Currently, we are struggling to finalise the project with NDoH, which is extremely unfortunate, especially after pharmacy owners put their hearts and soul into the campaign heeding the call to help from the government. We continue to engage to try and find solutions to the challenges we face when taking part in a public-private partnership.

DR PROSPER HIAG

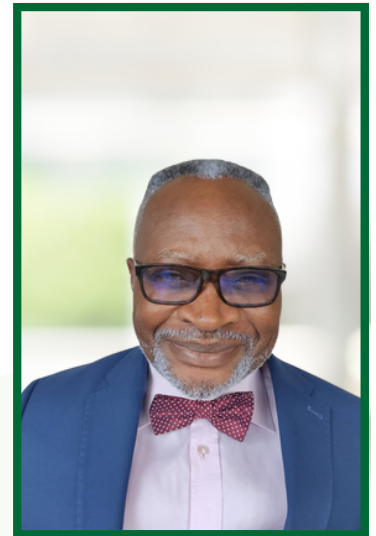
Dr Prosper Hiag - FIP Vice President (Cameroon)

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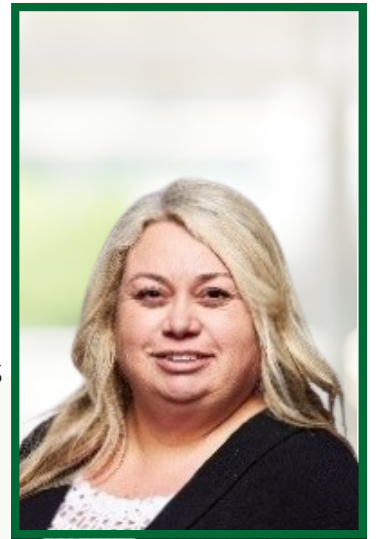

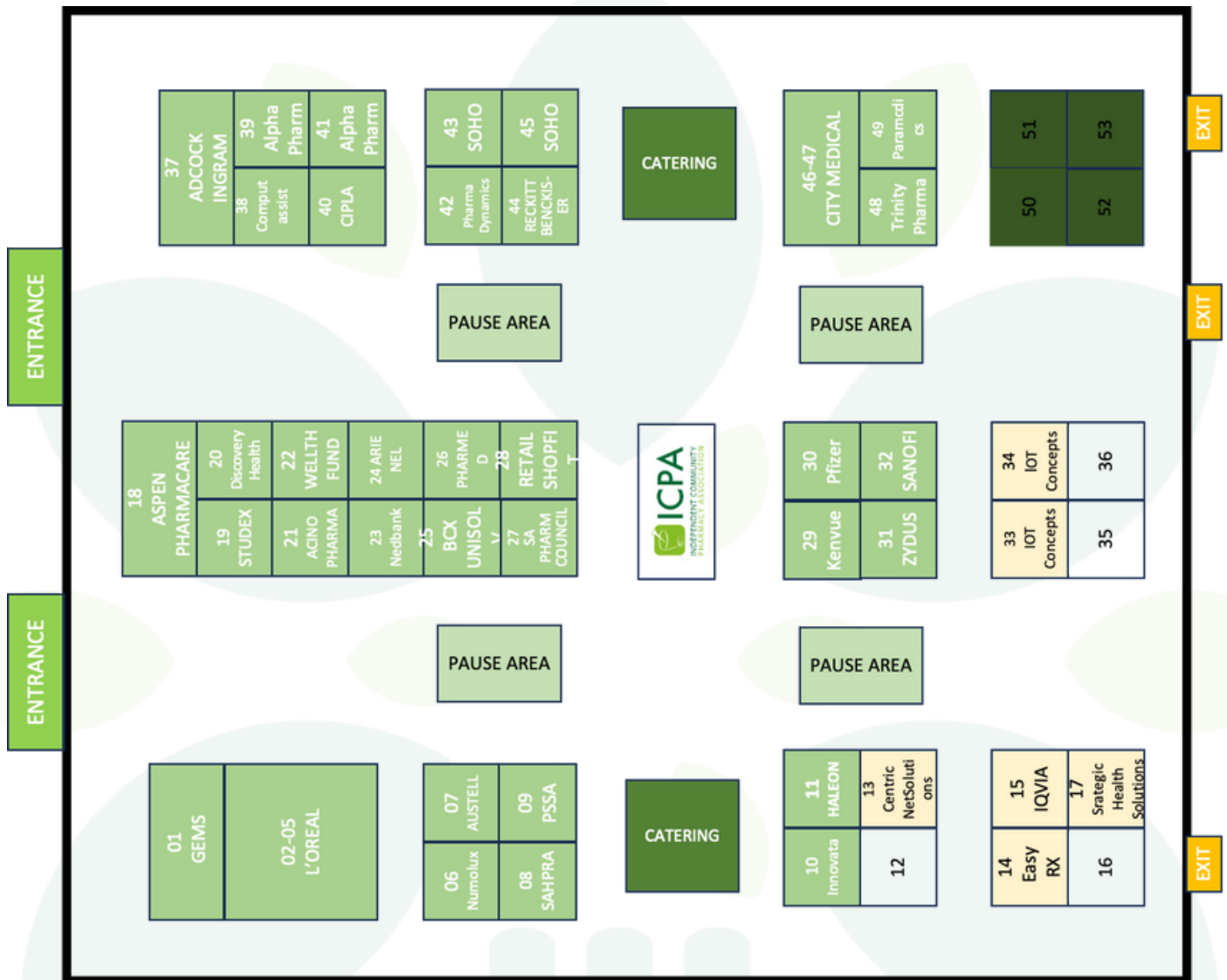
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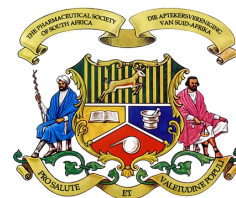
